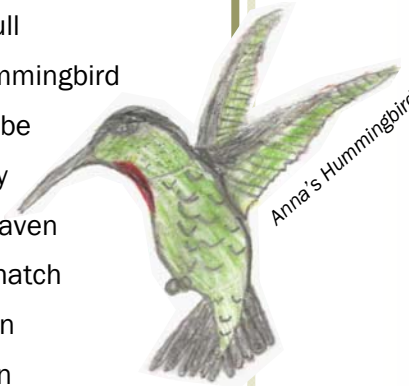
**Observations from students at the
